HOW CAN 1800 4 SUPPORT HELP ME?

All incidents where the safety and wellbeing of a child or young person is in question should be reported to 1800 4 SUPPORT.

Through working together, 1800 4 SUPPORT can assist by managing difficult conversations around child protection whilst conference members continue to engage with the family. We are also on hand to assist in navigating mandatory reporting requirements and assist with statutory reports to government agencies. We are able to identify and link families to additional supports that will allow a child or young person and their family to have choices for the future.
