


Engaging with Young People and the People we Serve

Buddies Day Program

Buddies - provide recreational for young people (5-12 yo), whose families are experiencing hardship and have sought assistance through Vinnies. The days also give parents and carers a little respite from caring responsibilities. Activities include visits to animal parks, movies, museums, water parks and fun-filled day programs facilitated at local schools. They provide disadvantaged young people with the opportunity to engage in new experiences and social activities that may not otherwise be available to them Our Youth volunteers buddy-up with a young person and participate alongside them for the day.







Who are the people we serve?

Families experiencing some level of hardship and seek support from Vinnies:

- Lower socioeconomic backgrounds
 - Domestic Violence
 - Hgh needs children
 - Children in foster care
- Families living in transitional housing
- Family needing a break or assistance through a difficult time





Why is it important?

For the Children

- Break from home life
 - Make new friends
- Educational opportunity
 - Fun outing
- Surrounded by positive role models at an important time of their development

For the Parents

- Provide a break for their children
 - Free childcare
- Give them time for themselves
- A chance to get their affairs in order knowing their children are safe and well taken care of

For the Volunteers

- Exposes them to people from different backgrounds and walks of life
 - Opportunity to flex their mentor skills
 - Reiterated the importance of giving back





Long Term Benefits

Some of the lasting benefits of this program for children include:

- Providing them with the space to just be a child
- To set appropriate boundaries and expectations on behaviour
 - Give them tools to grow such as books,
 educational experiences, positive roles models at a critical time in their development
- Watching the child grow and give them tools to help break the cycle of hardship as they enter adolescence




