WHAT ARE VINNIES SUPPORT CENTRES?

Vinnies Support Centres are client-centered support and referral services operated by the St Vincent de Paul Society. They offer face to face support to those in the community who require financial, food or material assistance. The support teams will work with you to offer the best possible support for your needs and link you in with the Society's Conference home visitation teams or Vinnies Services.

WHAT ARE OUR AIMS?

We provide advocacy, referrals and support in navigating the appropriate services. We'll have a conversation with you and allow you the time and space to discuss your needs. Our aim is to give you what you need to make informed decisions and improve your circumstance.

HOW DO WE DO IT?

We provide support and information through options such as:

- Advocating in your interests
- Referral to relevant services
- Assistance with completing forms and housing applications
- Resources and information
- Use of a computer (conditions apply)
- Assistance with bills (eg. utility bills)
- Food parcels and material aid (limits apply)
- Support in applying for the No Interest Loans Scheme (NILS)
- Linking people in with the Society's Conference home visitation teams
