Here are practical ideas to put into action.

1. Mentoring and Enabling others *Resource 1.5*

Choose 2 behaviours named in the document, 'Mentoring and enabling others' (*Resource 1.5*) that you think will make an impact with a leadership concern you currently have.

Consciously choose to use these 2 behaviours as much as possible in the next week or two. Make a note to yourself about how that goes.

2. Meeting Review *Resource 2.6*

Use the Meeting Review template at the end of a meeting you lead or are part of in the next couple of months. It only takes a few minutes to go through these questions.

Extra Challenge: Use it at more than meeting!!

What worked?	What didn't work?
What's possible?	What was missing?

You might like to use a white board or butchers paper to record the answers. If not available just take notes or ask someone to do that.

3. Managing Conflict at a Meeting *Resource 4.7*
