


An invitation to a new online course

Facilitating Faith in Action Part A



- Would you like to deepen your understanding of how our service is inspired by our spirituality?
- Would you enjoy sharing in a learning opportunity with members from other parts of the state?
- Is there a desire in you to encourage more conversations among members about how we put our faith into action?

We invite you to learn, explore, reflect upon how to support Conferences to be 'genuine communities of faith and love, of prayer and action' (The Rule, 3.3 page 20).

Facilitating Faith in Action is open to all members, volunteers, and employees. This 4-week course uses the Spiritual Adviser Handbook as a guide (available on MAVS: [Spiritual-adviser-handbook](#)) and combines reading, writing brief reflections and online engagement.

Part A begins the week of 13 September with most participants finishing in 4 weeks. Online conversations will be held during the week of 20 September and 3 October.

Part B (also 4 weeks) will be available shortly after Part A concludes

This course and the Handbook

- Aims to animate and facilitate Vincentian practice.
- Builds skill and confidence to encourage spiritual engagement.
- Is recommended for spiritual advisers (or aspiring ones), Conference Presidents and any member wanting to put faith and spirituality into action.
- Is available by invitation so we create a learning community for those participating.

The Course design

- Uses the Vinnies Learning Centre where learners log in and work at their own pace within a 4-week timeframe.
- Estimates that it will take a total of 6-10 hours to complete Part A over the 4 weeks.
